Lisa McGlynn was interviewed by *Law360* for an article exploring ways to retain women employees as many companies enter a 'new normal,' which means updating remote work policies and, in some cases, calling employees back into the office.

"For example, taking a hard stance at this point against options like remote or flexible work could backfire," she said. "You maybe didn't intend them to target a particular group, but the ultimate impact is going to be that it forces more women out of the workplace than men."
