Some lawyers suggest that office pools can be great morale boosters, they can also be illegal, and employers should take steps to minimize their exposure.

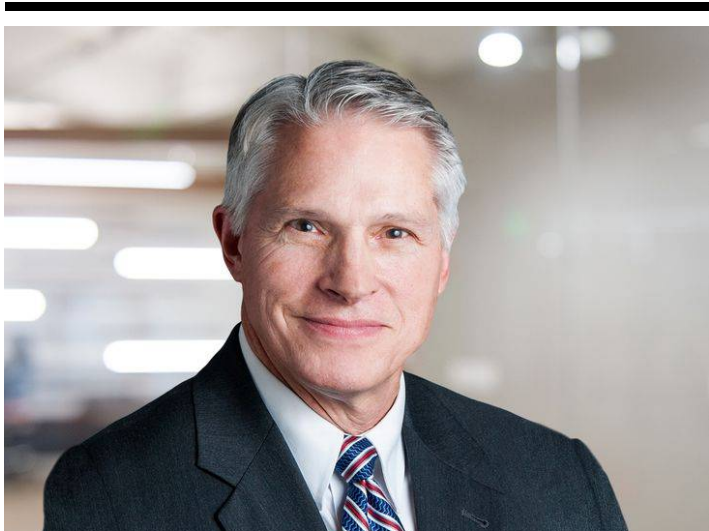
