BOSTON, MA (July 2, 2014) – Jeffrey A. Dretler, a partner in Fisher Phillips' Boston office, has been elected a Fellow by the College of Labor and Employment Lawyers, the firm announced today.

Election to the College is the highest national recognition possible by other labor and employment attorneys for sustained outstanding performance in the profession, exemplifying integrity, dedication and excellence. Dretler will be installed as a Fellow at the College's annual dinner on Nov. 8, 2014, coincident with an American Bar Association conference in Los Angeles.
