Shayna Balch was quoted in the *Phoenix Business Journal* on November 19, 2014. The article "Are We Really That Diverse? "The most identifiable religious claims that we have seen tend to deal with Middle Eastern religions, and those religions requiring certain dress codes," said Shayna.
