Scott was quoted on which rules with respect to entitlement to government and employer benefits will have to be reconsidered.

Scott said, “In 1972, the Supreme Court in *Baker v. Nelson* declared that a claim to gay marriage did not raise 'a substantial question' for the Court to resolve. In 2008, echoing the views of virtually every major national political figure, then-candidate Barack Obama said, 'I believe marriage is between a man and a woman. I am not in favor of gay marriage.'”
