Todd was quoted on his take of the proposal.

"I think what they're trying to do will ultimately be found illegal," said Todd.

He said one problem with the proposal is that federal antitrust law prohibits independent contractors from banding together to set prices.

"The ordinance is basically having these independent contractors engage in what's called price fixing," he said.
