



Local Attorneys Selected to Pennsylvania Super Lawyers, Rising Stars Lists

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PHILADELPHIA, PA (May 16, 2016) – Six attorneys in the Philadelphia office of Fisher Phillips have been selected for inclusion in this year's Pennsylvania *Super Lawyers* and five attorneys have been selected for *Rising Stars*.

Inclusion on the list is based on a process that involves nomination by third parties and peers, followed by independent research and ultimately a peer review process. The list is then published as a resource for clients seeking counsel.
