GULFPORT, MS (November 8, 2016) – Local Attorney Jaklyn Wrigley, an associate of Fisher Phillips in Gulfport, has been included in the *Mid-South Super Lawyers*’ 2015 Rising Stars list, an honor bestowed to less than 2.5 percent of lawyers in the area. This year marks the fourth year Wrigley has been designated as a Rising Star.

Wrigley is the Coast I District Director for the Board of the Young Lawyers Division of the Mississippi Bar and the Board Secretary and Chair of Collections Committee for the Walter Anderson Museum of Art.

To be eligible for inclusion in Rising Stars, a candidate must be either 40 years old or younger, or in practice for 10 years or less.

The Super Lawyers and Rising Stars lists are published nationwide in *Super Lawyers Magazine*, and in leading city and regional publications, and features profiles of attorneys who embody excellence in their practice of law.
