All airline travelers should expect delays because of added screening, said David Jones, a Memphis attorney with the global immigration practice group of Fisher Phillips, a national management-side labor and employment law firm. He also predicts it could take longer for U.S. citizens to get visas to any country, and to expect extra screening on entry to various Middle East countries. Some countries may put Americans through extra screening in retaliation to the U.S. travel restrictions, he said.
