Ed Foulke was quoted in the article “Former OSHA Head Predicts Shift From Enforcement to Compliance Assistance” featured in *The National Law Journal*. Ed, who held the top OSHA job under the George W. Bush administration from 2006 to 2008, predicts a greater focus on compliance and outreach over enforcement. He says there will likely be a shift in philosophy under the Trump administration away from Obama-era enforcement priorities.

“I want to get my clients to a point you don’t care if OSHA comes in. If you are just complying with the OSHA standards, you at best only have a fair safety program,” Ed says.
