Lambert advises that "Employers should emphasize to employees that they have a duty to report incidents, and train supervisors so that they're ready to identify threats, find people who persistently cause problems, or show warning signs like constantly lying or exhibiting a fascination with weapons.

Employees should be well-trained on a workplace violence policy so that best practices become second nature, the way repeated fire drills prepare us for a fire, he said.
