ATTORNEY COMMENTS ON NATIONAL SIGNIFICANCE OF MASS. NONCOMPETE REFORM

After 10 years of debate, the Massachusetts legislature has passed [noncompete reform](#). Michael Elkon discussed with reporters from [Associated Press](#), [The Washington Post](#), [Law 360](#), [SHRM](#) and [Business Insurance](#) how the legislation is emblematic of a larger trend of noncompete reform happening at the state level that is sweeping the country. Specifically, he told The Washington Post: "I can absolutely see other states picking it up. A bill in New Jersey, for instance, proposes requiring employers to pay workers their full pay if they're subject to the enforcement of a noncompete."
