

Attorney Comments on National Significance of Mass. Noncompete Reform

After 10 years of debate, the Massachusetts legislature has passed <u>noncompete reform</u>. Michael Elkon discussed with reporters from <u>Associated Press</u>, <u>The Washington Post</u>, <u>Law 360</u>, <u>SHRM</u> and <u>Business Insurance</u> how the legislation is emblematic of a larger trend of noncompete reform happening at the state level that is sweeping the country. Specifically, he told The Washington Post: "I can absolutely see other states picking it up. A bill in New Jersey, for instance, proposes requiring employers to pay workers their full pay if they're subject to the enforcement of a noncompete."
