Katherine Sandberg is quoted in the *Daily Journal* article “Supreme Court to Hear Arguments Over Whether Arbitration Act Exemption Applies To Transportation Contractors,” where she discusses the upcoming U.S. Supreme Court arguments in *Oliveira v. New Prime Inc.* The case hinges on whether the Federal Arbitration Act exempts independent contractors and whether that question should be answered by a court or an arbitrator.

Katherine says the case could go either way, but New Prime has the more compelling argument. She says, “I feel confident in saying I don’t think the Supreme Court is going to issue a decision and send the case back to arbitration.”
