In the November 2018 midterm election, Missouri voters passed a new minimum wage statute called Proposition B, which requires employers to pay close attention to how the law changes during the next five years. She says: "Employers need to make sure any lawful deductions they take from pay, like garnishments, doesn't dip employee pay below the minimum wage.
