

Attorney Discusses the Risk of Employee Data Loss with The Washington Post

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In an article about the risk of employee data loss, Philadelphia partner Risa Boerner tells *The Washington Post* that employees don't expect their employer to lose their data, so they take cyber breaches at work particularly hard. According to Risa, even if employees don't quit over a security problem, the bad publicity can negatively affect an employer's relationship with their employees. Companies are particularly at risk when working with third-party vendors that might not share their security standards. "This can be a serious, serious problem," Risa said. "You can do everything in terms of training your employee, but if you're handing it to a third party and they're not setting the same standard as you, you're putting that data at risk."
