

Fisher Phillips Attorney Addresses Massachusetts Paid Family and Medical Leave Bill

On July 1, Massachusetts businesses will be required to start paying the state to fund a new paid family and medical leave program for their employees, part of the "grand bargain" legislation passed on Beacon Hill this summer. Boston attorney Joshua Nadreau spoke with the *Boston Business Journal* about how any last-minute changes to this bill could affect employer's payroll systems in a big way. He told reporters, "If past is prologue with administration regulations, they tend to come very near the deadline or after the deadline."
