As developments continue to evolve surrounding when and how employers will need to report their pay data, Columbia partner Cheryl Behymer answered questions from *SHRM* regarding how to report the right information. Businesses with at least 100 employees and federal contractors with at least 50 employees and a contract with the federal government of \$50,000 or more must file the EEO-1 form. Cheryl says employers will need to figure out how to split the W-2 pay data into the 12 pay bands required for each of the 10 EEO-1 categories.
