Through WILC, Danielle brought to life her vision of a forum for attorneys to share experiences, bringing together women attorneys in the firm to share resources, exchange ideas and build business development opportunities. As a result of Danielle's boldness, coupled with the support of her colleagues within the firm, WILC is now a successful nationwide program and continues to benefit the firm's attorneys across 34 offices.

In her legal practice, Danielle represents employers in all aspects of labor and employment law, including discrimination, wrongful termination, harassment, retaliation and wage-and-hour class action lawsuits. She also counsels clients on employment handbook and personnel policy preparation and general preventive advice including hiring, discipline and termination practices.

Outside of her work with Fisher Phillips, Danielle is active in charitable organizations in the San Diego community, many of which seek to promote the interests of women, attorneys and students. Danielle has been the recipient of several awards in the regional and statewide business and legal communities. In 2018, she received the Lawyers Club of San Diego, "North County Service Award."
