In most industries, federal laws protect workers with disabilities, including mental illness. Church, however, is an exception. In an interview with *The Wall Street Journal*, Atlanta partner Myra Creighton explains that the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) doesn't apply to faith leaders. "In 2012, the Supreme Court ruled in favor of a 'ministerial exception' to the ADA," she said. "It's religious freedom. Courts don't want to get into telling churches who they may hire or fire."
