"At this point, the best course of action is to monitor information and educate your employees to reduce unfounded fears about travel, flying, and co-workers," he added. "The other critical step is to repeatedly, creatively, and aggressively encourage employees, students, and others to take steps to avoid the flu. Perhaps the most important message is to stay home if sick."
