In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) has issued new guidance for U.S. employers relating to things like reporting and the enforcement of respirator protection. In an interview with *Bloomberg Law*, **Ed Foulke** weighed-in on OSHA's latest clarification on work-related virus exposure and noted that the new guidance could be interpreted to focus primarily on health-care workers and first responders who have a higher likelihood of being exposed to the disease on the job.
