

## **Employers Should Prepare For Impact of Marriage Rulings**

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The U.S. Supreme Court's decisions in *United States v. Windsor* and *Hollingsworth v. Perry* will have profound cultural, political and social implications. And since, as Justice Anthony Kennedy noted in *Windsor*, the federal definition of the Defense of Marriage Act (DOMA) affects more than "1,000 federal statues and the whole realm of federal regulations," holding it unconstitutional has large-scale implications. One such area implicated is employment law.
