



Michigan Governor Narrows COVID-19 Leave Protections for Employees

Governor Gretchen Whitmer issued an Executive Order that limits the availability of job-protected leave only to those employees who pose a “particular risk of infecting others with COVID-19.” In an article published by *SHRM*, **Stephen Gee** describes that the Governor’s Executive Order is not retroactive in nature and is still more protective than CDC guidelines with regard to when an employee may return to work.
