In an interview with *Bloomberg Law* regarding a recent case involving a request under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) to release unredacted safety records, **Ed Foulke** explains that the precedential value of this particular case could extend beyond California. Ed anticipates the decision [to release the records] will force agencies to settle existing disputes. “More cases will be filed – or more FOIA request will be made, then we’ll see how OSHA responds,” he says.
