Tis' the season to worry about holiday party lawsuits.

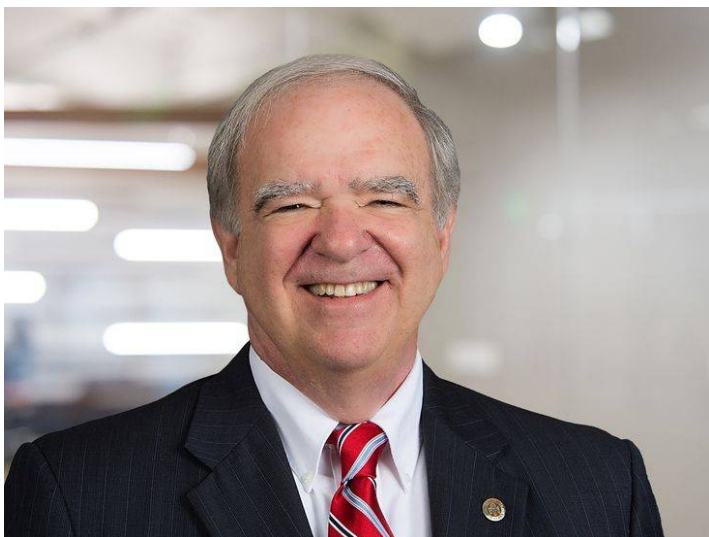
