Congress extended the current tax credits for voluntary sick leave pay to Sept. 30, 2021 and added a new reason for leave. Now, workers may be eligible for time off to receive the COVID-19 vaccine or if they are having side effects related to receiving the vaccine. Megan shares insight that she is receiving a lot of questions from employers about how to incentivize workers to get the vaccine and advises that paid leave is a good option for many.
