It appears that the federal Occupational Safety and Health Administration is preparing to issue new short-term regulations to protect workers from catching COVID-19 on the job. Travis anticipates that the federal rules may look a lot like Virginia's OSHA rules and says employers will likely see a stringent face-covering requirement and requirements that employees have free access to the vaccine.
