Hagood Tighe, co-chair of Fisher Phillips' Wage and Hour practice, recently spoke with Law360 for a two-part series focused on the top wage and hour issues that the Biden administration plans to tackle. Hagood predicts an increase in enforcement efforts from the DOL's Wage and Hour Division with a more aggressive posture, particularly with employers that they think are not making a good faith effort to comply with new laws. He also weighs in on the roll back of the rule regarding when businesses can classify workers as independent contractors and the possibility of bipartisan action on a federal minimum wage.
