

Ohio Lawyers Provide Five Points for Businesses to Consider in Response to State's Revised Health Order

- 1. Be aware of local regulations.
- 2. Understand that future OSHA guidance is expected.
- 3. Be ready for difficult decisions in monitoring vaccine status of employees.
- 4. Consider the legal and practical issues involved in requesting proof of vaccinations.
- 5. Adopt anti-retaliation and anti-harassment policies with respect to the new rules.

In the end, the authors recommend that Ohio businesses think through the process and develop a detailed plan of action to avoid some potential pitfalls created by the State's latest guidance.
