The list considers possible priorities relevant to labor and employment law for the U.S. Congress and the Trump administration now that the Democratic Party will be in the majority in the U.S. House of Representatives. Types of legislation expected (immigration, worker-friendly bills in the House); possible Trump-distraction by the Democrats in the House; another attempt, perhaps in the lame-duck session, to repeal the Affordable Care Act; judicial nominations ramping up in the U.S. Senate; and how the U.S. Supreme Court decision in *Janus* regarding mandatory union dues may affect elections are all explored.

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


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
