



Workplace Safety Partners Detail Steps Companies Can Take to Ensure Correct Injury Reports to OSHA

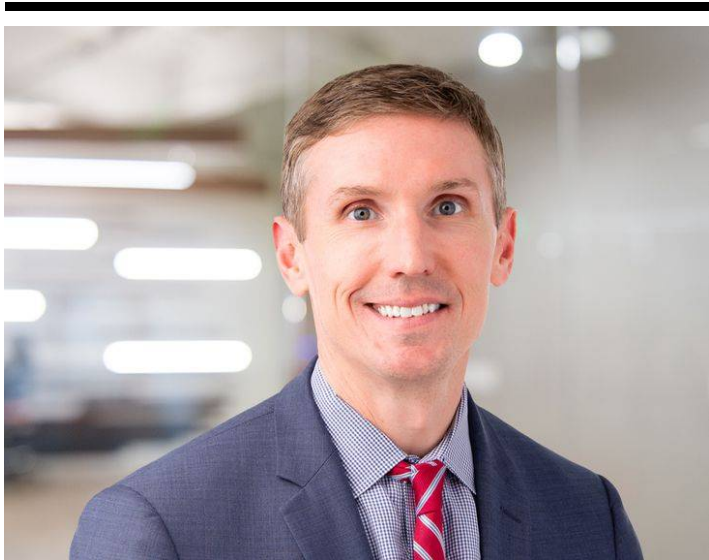
