In an interview with McKnight's Senior Living, **Micah Dickie** and **Patrick Dalin** encourage skilled nursing facility and senior living community operators to remain vigilant to the threat COVID-19 still poses to the workplace. Micah explains that even though the Occupational Safety and Health Administration's (OSHA's) COVID-19 focused inspection initiative has ended, long-term care providers remain under intense scrutiny.
