



Irvine Partner Breaks Down FTC's Proposed Document Retention Regulations with Automotive News

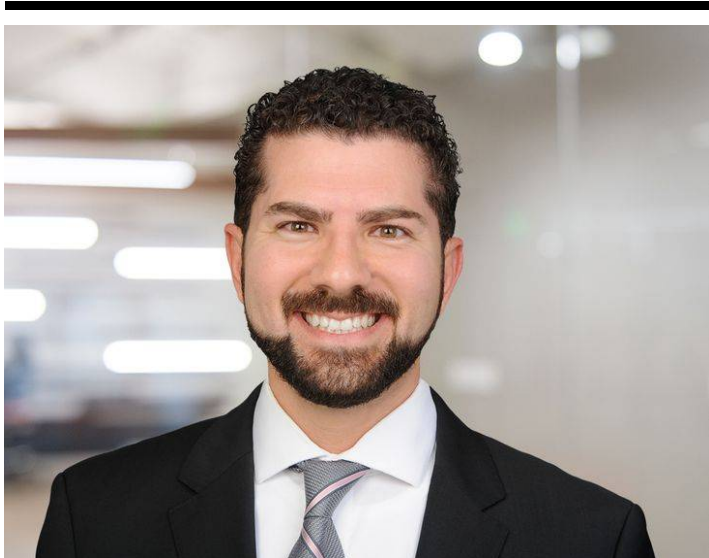

In an interview with *Automotive News*, **Usama Kahf** shares his insight on how automotive employers can prepare for the Federal Trade Commission's proposed document retention regulations and the potential impact it may have on workplace policies.
