The California Consumer Privacy Act (CCPA) requires affected businesses to take various steps to protect the personal information they collect about consumers, employees, and job applicants.

As of January 1, 2023, employers subject to the CCPA, as amended by the California Privacy Rights Act (CPRA), must comply with a series of data privacy obligations affecting employment and job-related data.
