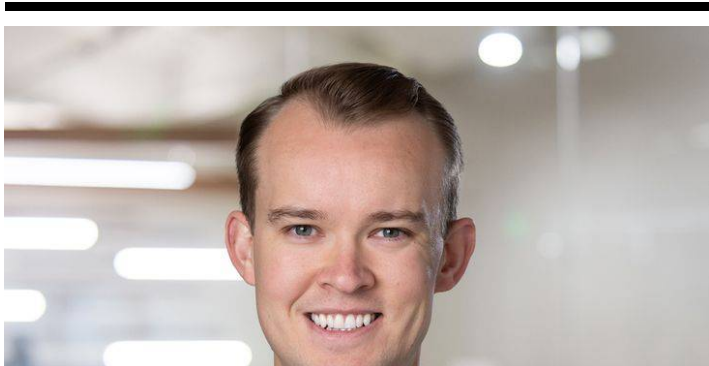
At Fisher Phillips, James will represent employers in workplace law disputes and provide companies with counseling and advice on all aspects of their employment relationships.
