

# Pittsburgh Post-Gazette Turns to Labor Attorneys for Insight on Cannabis Labor Peace Agreements

In an article published in *The Pittsburgh Post-Gazette*, **Todd A. Lyon, co-chair of Fisher Phillips' Labor Relations practice,** and **Alexander A. Wheatley** are quoted for <u>their insight</u> on the legality of labor peace agreements in the cannabis industry. Organizing efforts at a Pennsylvania cannabis store are raising questions about whether the state's licensing preferences - which open the door for unionization in exchange for labor peace at their stores - will hold up in court. They explain, "given that the state requirements impose obligations where the National Labor Relations Act does not, there is a strong argument that these laws are entirely or largely pre-empted by the NLRA."
