

John Polson Pens Article for Staffing Success on Managing Antitrust Violation Risks

In a bylined article published in *Staffing Success Magazine*, **John Polson** discusses a recent case where a Nevada health care staffing firm pled guilty to criminal antitrust allegations for workplace misdeeds. The U.S. Department of Justice alleged that the private staffing company knowingly engaged in a conspiracy to suppress competition when placing contract nurses at schools. According to the indictment, the company made a pact with a competitor not to recruit each other's nurses and to fix their wages.

John explains that staffing firms are concerned about losing good employees, but given the new focus on labor-market antitrust investigations, employers should consider taking preventative measures to ensure compliance and avoid criminal prosecution. He proceeds to outline six steps for antitrust compliance for staffing companies.
