Training is Key to Mine Operators' Safety and Compliance ...



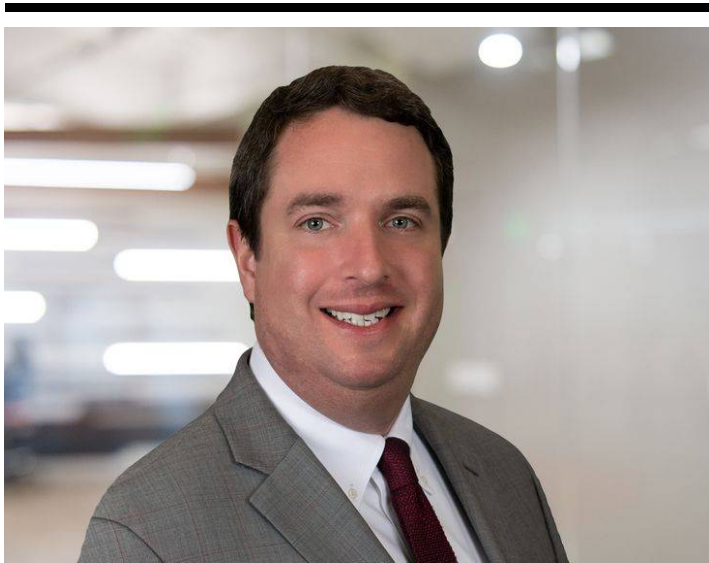
