With over 10,000,000 people in the United States without immigration status, approximately 1 in 30 employees will not possess appropriate documentation for completing Form I-9. As we come out of the COVID era, U.S. Immigration & Customs Enforcement (ICE) will again become active in enforcing employers' compliance. While completing the Form I-9 may seem simple, establishing the best practices for a compliance program is complex.
