- Part of the three lawyer team that successfully limited the expansion of the professional ethical guidelines "implied by law" exception to New York's employment at will doctrine, in litigation before New York State's highest court (*Horn v. New York Times*, NY. Ct. App. 2003)
- Successfully defended insurance company and its retirement plan in age discrimination and ERISA litigations by two former employees in the U.S. District Court for Minnesota, resulting in summary judgment on behalf of defendants in both cases and an award of costs and attorney's fees in favor of defendants based on litigation conduct by plaintiff's counsel in one case.
