The Pregnant Workers Fairness Act (PWFA) is a federal law that requires covered employers to provide reasonable accommodations to a worker's known limitations related to pregnancy, childbirth, or related medical conditions unless the accommodation will cause the employer an "undue hardship," first went into effect on June 27, 2023, and the final regulations on April 15, 2024. 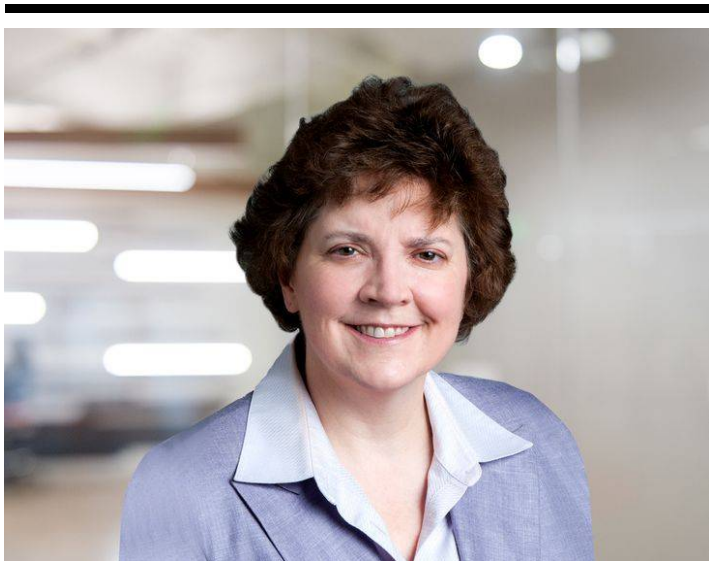
