

U.S. Department of Labor's OSHA Extends Compliance Date for Electronically Submitting Injury, Illness Reports to December 15, 2017

Today, OSHA posted a press release announcing two week reprieve for employers to submit the 300As (only the 300As this year regardless of size if more than 20 employees) from December 1 to December 15, 2017. The link also lists the states that have not yet adopted the recordkeeping regulation and for which there is no current requirement to submit the electronic data.
