

Labor Relations Vice Chair Discusses Loyola Marymount Decision to Withdraw Recognition of Its Faculty Union

In an interview with *Los Angeles Times*, **Joshua Nadreau** discussed Loyola Marymount University's decision to withdraw recognition of its faculty union after 10 months of negotiations, citing constitutional religious exemptions. Josh said the motivation may not ultimately have weight, since the labor board, even with a Democratic majority, has sided with universities on this issue in recent years.
