

Immigration Co-Chair Discusses New H-1B Social Media Vetting Rules

In an interview with *SHRM*, **Jocelyn Campanaro** shares her insight on how new social media vetting rules will reshape the visa process for H-1B workers and their families. She notes that "any mismatch between an applicant's online profile and the H-1B petition — job title, employer, duties, dates, education — may lead to follow-up questioning or delays." She also highlighted that a spouse's or child's online statements, images, or political posts may trigger enhanced scrutiny for the entire family.
