FP AI FORUM: HOW TO STOP AI SLOP

If you've been on the receiving end of a suspiciously perfect email with lots of em-dashes, a resume that reads exactly like your job posting, or a 3-page policy document that doesn't actually say anything, you have been exposed to "AI slop." There's a right way and a wrong way to use AI, and the wrong way is actually creating risks for employers: brand erosion, productivity theater, cultural drift, and legal exposure.
