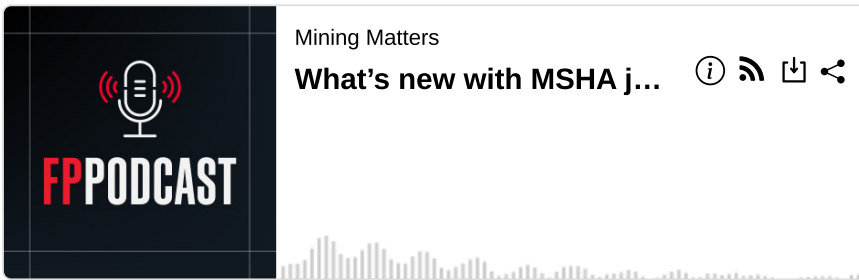

MINING MATTERS: WHAT'S NEW WITH MSHA JURISDICTION? A REVIEW OF RECENT IMPORTANT DECISIONS

The Mine Safety and Health Administration (MSHA) has jurisdiction over “mines” and mining and milling processes. But there is no bright line as to when MSHA has jurisdiction and when it does not. Instead, determinations are made on fact-specific case-by-case bases. Two recent court decisions highlight the factors considered in jurisdictional determinations: The D.C. Circuit’s *KC Transport* decision and the Review Commission’s *Cactus Canyon* decision.
