This webinar will provide attendees with the practical guidance necessary to address the emerging case law undermining the ability of California employers to manage employee breaks. In *Augustus, et al. v. ABM Security Services, Inc*, the California Supreme Court reversed the 2nd District Court of Appeal, concluding that, “state law prohibits on-duty and on-call rest periods.” This decision, coupled with prior rulings regarding employee meal periods, has created an environment in which employers have great difficulty complying with the *Labor Code*. This is especially the case for employers in the transportation industry, where drivers are required to attend vehicles at all times.

By providing a brief background of the state of the law and detailing the best practices to address these difficulties, we hope to empower employers to manage their workforce while minimizing liability.
