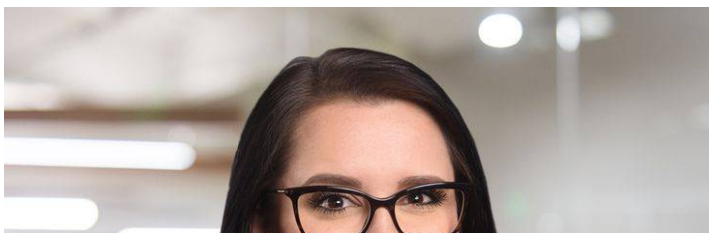
- What are employers' legal obligations related to the virus and its impact on employees?
