Rosemary pointed out that there could be a downside to managers seeing photos of job applicants. Images allow them to see a person's race, disability, or age. Most employers don't discriminate based on an individual's looks, but there are managers out there who pick candidates not based on qualifications, but on attractiveness. That reality could pose legal issues for an employer. "You, as an employer, are better off not knowing," she stressed.
